1. Organization

12th FAI World Paraski Parachuting Championship 2009 organised by

- Federation Aeronautique Internationale of Avenue Mon Repos 24, CH 1005 Lausanne, Switzerland (FAI)
- Oesterreichischer Aeroclub (ÖAEC) – Sektion Fallschirmspringen, Prinz Eugen Strasse 12, A-1040, Vienna/Austria (National Member)
- National Aeroclub of Austria Landessektion Steiermark / AQUALIFE–GRAZ, Eduard Peserl, Hermann–Austgasse 17/6, A-8054 Graz/Austria (Organizer)

2. Aims of the FCE

- World Champions in Para Ski individual – male and female separately,
- World Champions in Team Para Ski – male and mixed gender teams together and then separately – female teams and junior teams,
- World Champions in Para Ski Junior (born on or after 01/01/1985 – age of 24) – male and female separately,
- Winner of the World Masters Class Para Ski (born on or before 31/12/1959 – age of 50) – male and female separately.

3. Date and place of the FCE

10. – 15 March 2009 in Donnersbachwald / Riesneralm – Styria – Austria.

4. General Information

Training jumps: Monday 9th March 2009 from 10:00 to 17:00, and Tuesday 10th March 2009 from 10:00 to 17:00. The jumps must be booked in advance (official entry form), the fee is € 30,00 for each jump.

Training slalom: There is no official slalom training. Each team can organize ski training by its–self with the technical support of the organizing local ski–club.

Aircraft: Ecureuil or similar helicopter (4 parachutists) with an exit speed of approx. 60 – 80 kts

Personal requirements: To take part in the event, a valid FAI Sport License 2009 is requested. For the slalom competition the rigid helmet is compulsory.

Each participating country should also bring a national flag (size: 100 cm x 150 cm) and a tape/CD with the national anthem for the opening ceremony.

Insurance requirements: Each competitor should have a valid accident insurance; The minimum amount of coverage required in Austria by law is € 1.500.000,00. Liability insurance, covering Officials, Judges, etc., will be arranged by the Organizer. This optional insurance will be put at the disposal of the aforementioned persons at the price of € 52,00 and has to be booked in advance. The immediate medical First Aid to the participants is the responsibility of the Organizer during the official event, including training days.

Registration: Office "Talstation Riesneralm" Donnersbachwald
Monday 9th March 2009 from 13:00 to 17:00 and Tuesday 10th March 2009 from 10:00 to 17:00.

Accommodations: The name and other details about the hotels, where the teams will be on Monday 9th or Tuesday 10th (depend on the arriving), will be communicated by the organizing committee as soon as the official entry form will be received.

Health care / Physikopractic

Physikopractic treatment is possible – the competitors will be accompanied by an experienced and well educated practitioner the whole week (before, during and after competition, one for each team). This service will be free of charge, but it has to be booked in advance with the official entry form until January, 29th 2009 or send me an email for that. Further information: www.paraski.at

Transport: Delegations are responsible for their own transportation to Donnersbachwald. Transfers in Donnersbachwald must be booked in advance, if you don't have a car – however, it is a 5 minute walk to the ski area and to the drop zone.

Entry fees

- **The provisional entry form must be submitted before December, 25th 2008**
- **The official entry form must reach the organizer no later than January, 24th 2009**

The entry fees must be paid within a week after the official entry deadline (29th January 2009). The receipt has to be presented till Wednesday 11th March before 17:00 and will be issued by the organizing committee as soon as the payment through the bank is completed.

- Late entries are accepted until Tuesday 10th March 2009 at 16:00 p.m. with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.
- Late payments are accepted until Tuesday 10th March 2009 at 17:00 with a penalty of € 50,00 per person.

If the two described situations happen together, the organizing committee will apply max € 50,00 of penalty per person.

The delegations that do not pay the entry fees in time are not allowed to take part in the competition.
